Hedge cutting

Mr Backshall has been in touch with Island Roads regarding the overgrown hedge just past the White Lion public house. They are aware of the problem and have already issued a 'hedge notice' to the land owner requesting them to cut it back.

If the land owner does not reply then another process begins whereby they contact the Council to get permission to cut the hedge themselves and then charge the land owner.

Island Roads are fully aware of the risks for parents and their children as the hedge is restricting the width of the pavement, however are unable to do anything initially until the 14 day notice period has elapsed. They did say though that if parents expressed their concerns to Island Roads it may speed up the process which could take weeks.
