### **School Day**

An adult will be on duty at 8:10am (please do not leave your child unattended before this time). At 8:15am, those children on the playground will go into their classroom. Children arriving after 8:15am should head straight to their classroom. All children should be in the classroom by 8:25am for registration.

School finishes at 2.30pm - KS1

2.45pm - KS2 plus siblings from KS1

All pupils are to be collected from the shelter at the far end of the second field, next to the car park at the White Lion.

Year 5 and 6 pupils are allowed to walk either to the collection shelter, Arreton Barns or home with written permission from the parent.

### **Parking**

#### **Key Stage 1 (Reception, Year 1 & Year 2)**

Parents/carers who have children in our Reception, Year 1, or Year 2 should use the community car park next to the White Lion public house. The children need to be in the playground by 8.15am to be collected by their Teacher or Teaching Assistant. Once collected please leave the car park as soon as possible so car parking spaces are continually available.

After school you again can use the community car park and need to be there in time to collect your child for 2.35pm. Once you have collected your child, it is vitally important that you vacate the car park as soon as you can. If there is no space when you arrive in the community car park then please use the over-flow car park at Arreton Barns and walk down to the collection shelter.

### Key Stage 2 (Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 & Year 6)

Parents/carers who have children in our Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 or Year 6 should use the over-flow car park at Arreton Barns and walk down to the school. The children need to be in the playground by 8.15am to be collected by their Teacher or Teaching Assistant.

After school you again use the over-flow car park at Arreton Barns and need to be there in time to collect your child for 2.50pm at the collection shelter.

It would be very much appreciated if you avoid parking in the community car park both in the morning and the afternoon. Please do not park in the car park next to the school or in school lane.

### Uniform

We feel that it is desirable that all children should wear school uniform as it encourages a sense of belonging and discourages the wearing of clothes which are unsuitable for school activities.

If at any time you need support with costs related to school uniform, please do not hesitate to contact us for confidential advice and support.

PE kit remains in school and is sent home for washing at the end of each half term unless it becomes very dirty. Please bring PE kit on your first day.

### **Break time snacks**

KS1 - Fruit and milk is provided free of charge to all KS1 pupils.

KS2 - The children are allowed to bring fruit from home.

Chartwells also have a tuck shop every day, the prices are:

-Toast,  $\frac{1}{2}$  teacake, crumpet, raisins frube, Orange juice cuplet, apple juice cuplet or milk.

30p for one item 50p for two.

The children will be responsible for their own money.

Fresh water is available all day - each child needs to bring their own water bottle.

### **Assemblies**

Assemblies are held daily. Each Key stage has regular celebration assemblies. If your child is involved you will be invited to attend via a text message.

### **Parent/teacher meetings**

Meetings between parents and teachers are held regularly throughout the year but staff are always available to answer questions and resolve concerns at the start and finish of each day.

### **Holidays and absence from school**

If your child is ill and unable to attend school please contact the school office before 9am on the first day an illness.

Please inform your child's class teacher and the school office of any

appointments which may mean your child is late for school or needs to leave part way through the day.

All Holiday requests must be made on an official form available from the school office. Holiday during term time is not authorised and may result in a fixed penalty notice issued by Educational Welfare Services.

### **After school clubs**

The school offers a range of after school clubs, details of dates, times and cost are sent home together with a booking form at the start of each term.

### **School dinners**

A hot meal is available each day provided by Chartwells, please look under the parents section on our school website for the latest Chartwells menu.

Key Stage 1 (Reception, Years 1 & 2) receive Universal Infant Free School Meal's. For Key Stage 2 (Years 3, 4, 5 & 6) the cost is £2.15 per day. Your child may be eligible for Free School Meals, please contact School Admissions on 01983 821000 for help and guidance.

Please send dinner money into school in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name and class. Card and cheque payment is also accepted.

Monies can be paid half- termly, weekly in advance or daily. A half termly menu is sent home with each child.
