EYFS Gruffalo Class Autumn Term 1 and 2

This curriculum map is a guide to what we will be covering this half-term. The best Early Years practice is when planning and teaching adapts to the current interests and needs of the current cohort, so as our plans change we will update you via Tapestry.

During the first few weeks it is very important that we all get to know each other and understand our Golden Rules. We will also be talking about our School Values of Perseverance, Honesty and Friendship.

Phonics: We will be starting Phase 2 of Letters and Sounds and learning the following phonemes: s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, h, b, f, ff, l, ll, ss. We will be teaching the children how to blend and segment sounds.



Getting to know you



RE: Special People. Our friends and family. Jesus for Christians.

Literacy: Using *Pete the Cat* as a prompt, we will be thinking about all the things we are doing at school, and sharing our favourite thing. We will then make our own book *Arreton Children Rocking in their School Shoes*.

Maths: We will consolidate counting from 1 to 10. We will be learning to identify and recognise numerals to 10 and to count a variety of groups of objects. We will begin to recognise and name 2D shapes in the surrounding environment.



PE: Multi - Skills
Mrs Parker will be teaching PE on Thursday mornings.

As a parent you can: Read with/to your child every day; Practise the sound cards and high frequency words; Use everyday language to talk about time, distance and money; Add observations to Tapestry about things that your child is doing at home.



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We will be exploring light and looking at Festivals around the world that involve light, including Diwali, Bonfire Night Christmas and Hanukkah.


Phonics: We will be consolidating Phase 2 of Letters and Sounds and beginning Phase 3. This introduces more digraphs and trigraphs. We will be decoding, segmenting and blending words.

Light and Dark





RE: Incarnation: Why do Christians perform nativity plays at Christmas?

Literacy: Using *We're Going on a Bear Hunt*, and *Recipe For a Story*, we will be drawing story maps and narrating our own stories. We will be using our phonic knowledge to write parts of the story ourselves.



Maths: We will be estimating how many objects are in a group, and then counting to check. We be using the language 'more' and 'fewer', and will be finding the total of two groups by adding them together. We will be using everyday language related to time.
