The children have been talking about different Super Heroes. Using the book *Supertato* as a prompt, we will be exploring this theme through role-play and creating our own Super Heroes.

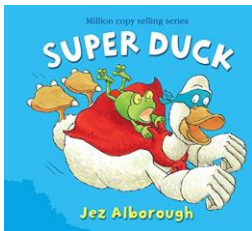
Phonics: We will be consolidating the Phase 2 sounds and continuing to blend and segment words. We will be continuing Phase 3, which typically lasts 12 weeks. This phase introduces more digraphs and trigraphs.

Super Heroes

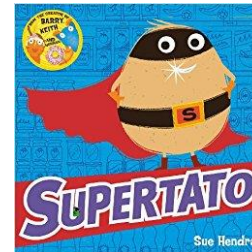


RE: Special Things. The Cross and the Bible for Christians and the Torah for Jewish people.

Literacy: We will be focusing on reading and writing high frequency words, and beginning to write sentences using our phonic knowledge.



Maths: Count objects accurately to 10 and beyond. Say the number that is one more or one less than a given number. Record findings, using marks they can interpret and explain. Use everyday language related to time and money. Order and sequence familiar events. Use mathematical names for 2D and 3D shapes.



PE: Dance
Mrs Parker takes PE on a Thursday morning. Please ensure your child's kit is in school.

As a parent you can: Read with/to your child every day; Practise the sound cards and high frequency words; Use everyday language to talk about time, distance and money; Add observations to Tapestry about what your child does at home.
