## Parking

Dear Parents/ Carers,

Thank you for your patience and co-operation this week with the parking issues. I have devised a solution which I hope will relieve the issues and make the situation much easier but it will rely on your co-operation. The plan is as follows:

### **Mornings:**

- I will stand by the top gate from 8.10am. We will have 2 other members of staff supervising the children as they walk down the path into school.
- This will allow you to pull up and drop your children off without having to park.
- If you still wish to park and take your children in yourself you are welcome to do so.
- We are also going to use our House captains to escort the younger children to their classrooms.

### **Afternoons:**

- All children in year R, 1 & 2 will finish school at 2.30pm. The children will be brought up to the top gate by the shelter where they can be collected by parents.
- Any children in these year groups with older siblings will be kept in school until 2.45pm.
- All parents of children in year R, 1 & 2 only must vacate the car park by 2.40pm.
- Children in years 3 & 4 plus any siblings will be brought up to the top gate at 2.45pm where they can be collected by parents.
- Parents are asked to leave the car park as quickly as possible.
- Children in years 5 & 6 will be released at 2.50pm and providing permission has been given, walk up to the top gate. Parents will be able to just pull in and allow their children to jump in, staff will be at the gate to ensure this is done in a safe way.
- Staff will hold onto any younger siblings of year 5 & 6 children until their parents arrive and assist with getting the children safely into cars.
- **This will only work if parents with children in the older years do not arrive at school before 2.40pm and the parents with children in the younger years only vacate the car park promptly.**
- Parents will still be able to collect from the school playground if they have not parked in the top car park.

We will trial this for the next week and would welcome any feedback, comments or suggestions that you have.
